This Week's Treviglas Focus – Self Belief

1. A Message from the Headteacher

Self-belief is an inner confidence that you can be successful in a particular situation or on a specific task. Your self-belief is related to your self-esteem, which is feeling good about yourself and feeling that you are worthwhile. Many young people will struggle with low confidence levels during their years in secondary school.

Self-belief helps teenagers make safe, informed decisions. Confident young people often avoid people and situations that aren't necessarily right for them, and to find those that are.

Our young people show us when they have self-belief. Some of the signs include:

- a good posture
- a relaxed walk
- an ability to give and receive praise
- openness to criticism and feedback
- a curiosity about new ideas
- a refusal to get upset when things go differently than planned.

2. Mrs Drake – Teaching and Learning

Reflection is a fundamental part of teaching and it is important that we find those moments of reflection in each day. We need to find the space to think about, and celebrate, our successes, as well as consider aspects of our practice that we will continue to develop.

A key area that we must continue to reflect upon is how we are checking the understanding of the learning of all students in the lesson. When using the whiteboards, did we really check that all students had understood the learning? Did we use the information to adapt our teaching? Did we ensure that every student was focused after the silent attention routine, looking at the board during the modelling process? As we continue to think about these aspects of teaching practice, please do revisit the Walkthrus. Each video is only a couple of minutes long and, together with the slides, provide a step by step approach for teaching techniques.

Their flexible and adaptable curriculum-based sessions do this through engagement with real-life stories, up-to-date scientific, psychological and sociological research, creative media, interactive content, and peer-led discussions.

This week, as part of the ever adaptive PSHE curriculum, all year 8 and year 9 students received a one-hour workshop from experts in their field. Year 8 learned about the dangers of social media use while year 9 learned about the importance of kindness and compassion.
