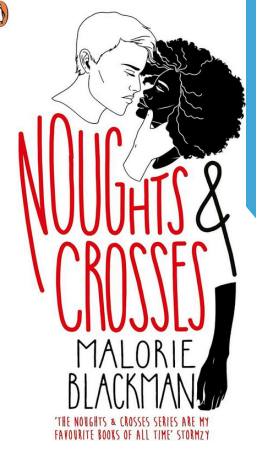
Year 9 should have now booked their activities for Activities Week in the final week of the academic year, which will be a highlight for all to enjoy after an unforgettable year!
