

KEY STAGE 4 RESULTS 2023

In 2023, students sat external examinations to gain their qualifications. Despite the challenges faced by the pandemic, we have continued to build on improvement.

This year our Progress 8 score was 0.16.

This means that on average all of our students achieved higher grades across all their subjects, compared to similar students nationally.

This was even better than our 2022 results (0.06) and placed us sixth in the county in terms of progress and the top performing school in North Cornwall.

59% of our students achieved the important benchmark of achieving a Grade 4+ in both English and Maths

37% of our students achieved the important benchmark of achieving a Grade 5+ in both English and Maths

18% of our students achieved a grade 7 and above in maths

40% of our students achieved a grade 5 and above in maths

64% of our students achieved a grade 4 and above in maths

18% of our students achieved a grade 7 and above in English

57% of our students achieved a grade 5 and above in English

73% of our students achieved a grade 4 and above in English

SUBJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Biology 83% achieved a grade 5 and above, 37% achieved a grade 7 and above

Chemistry 80% achieved a grade 5 and above, 38% achieved a grade 7 and above

Physics 85% achieved a grade 5 and above, 38% achieved a grade 7 and above

Art 65% achieved a grade 5 and above, 20% achieved a grade 7 and above

Drama 62% achieved a grade 5 and above, 29% achieved a grade 7 and above

DT 55% achieved a grade 5 and above, 14% achieved a grade 7 and above

Sport 42% achieved a Level 2 Distinction Star. 93% achieved a Level 2 pass or above.

Travel and Tourism 33% achieved a Level 2 DistinctionStar. 92% achieved a Level 2 pass or above.

Engineering 27% achieved a Level 2 Distinction or above. 73% achieved a Level 2 pass or above.
