

# **Treviglas Academy Home School Agreement**

Treviglas Academy aims to provide the highest quality of education for all students, in order that they can attain the highest levels of achievement. Treviglas Academy views the Home School Agreement as an essential element of our strategy with respect to the partnership between parents/carers and students. This agreement should be read in conjunction with the following policies: Behaviour Policy, Uniform Policy, Attendance Policy. All policies are available to view on the Treviglas website (if you would like these in different accessibility formats please contact Treviglas Academy directly).

#### **Parents**

- 1. I will always be polite to all staff at Treviglas Academy.
- 2. I will send my child to school every day and aim for 100% attendance. Only the most extreme circumstances would prevent me from doing this.
- 3. I will organise all routine medical and dental appointments for my child during school holidays, training days and after school.
- 4. I will download the Satchel One, Gateway and Pupil Progress App and read all letters and emails sent.
- 5. I will check Satchel daily during term time and track my child's progress.
- 6. I will ensure that I update my contact details immediately if they change.

#### **Uniform and equipment**

- 1. I will adhere to the uniform policy in full and ensure that my child goes to school properly dressed in accordance with this.
- 2. I understand that the minimum equipment needed by my child daily is a pencil case, 2 x pens, 2 x pencils, ruler, rubber and a scientific calculator and a bag large enough to carry an A4 folder.
- 3. I will check the website photos of shoes and check with a member of the senior team if I am not sure about the type of shoes allowed.
- 4. I understand that school shirts must be tucked in at all times and that students will receive a sanction if they are not adhering to the uniform policy.

### **Expectations**

- 1. I will ensure my child follows all points in the behaviour policy.
- 2. I understand that an after school detention may mean that I have to arrange transport to collect my child. I understand this is my responsibility.
- 3. I understand that items such as phones, ear pods, smart watches and jewellery will be confiscated if used outside of school policy. These items will be held by the school until collection and the school will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.
- 4. I understand that persistent poor and unacceptable behaviour or serious behaviour can result in a prolonged period of time spent in the Reset Room.
- 5. I understand that unacceptable student behaviour, which brings the school's reputation into disrepute, can be sanctioned. This applies at any time, including when the student is not on school premises.
- 6. I understand that the school does occasional searches of jumpers, blazers, trouser pockets and bags for prohibited items in accordance with our behaviour policy.
- 7. I understand that if my child is returning to school following a period of suspension, I will attend a parental meeting with either the Head of Year for my child or a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

## Homework/ internet usage

- 1. I will support my child by monitoring their homework, checking homework is completed and supervising online homework on Satchel, Tassomai and Sparx Maths.
- 2. I understand that homework is compulsory and failure to complete may result in sanctions.
- 3. I will ensure my child always uses the internet appropriately, sensibly, and safely.

I believe that Treviglas Academy has the best interest of my child in mind and I will support the school's decision making. I understand that by doing this, my child will have a greater chance of success, and this is what I want for my child.

Once you and your child have accepted the place at Treviglas Academy, the Home School Agreement becomes binding and you are expected to abide by it.
