### **Home-School Agreement**

Everybody at Treviglas Academy recognises that the successful education of its students depends on an effective partnership between the school, students and parents/carers. All three parties share responsibility for the development and achievement of each student. We expect our whole community to:

**Attend every day**

**Practise kindness**

**Work hard**

**Value ourselves**

As a student - I will:

- be properly equipped
- behave responsibly and be polite to others in the school and in the wider community
- treat others as I would wish to be treated
- work hard in class and at home so that I can achieve my full potential
- complete homework on time
- take part in eXtra@ activities offered by the school
- care for the environment in and out of school
- ensure all school books are kept neat and tidy and are graffiti-free
- understand that any misbehaviour whilst wearing school uniform will be dealt with as if the incident occurred at school
- make a positive contribution within our community through helping others, for example, through leadership, mentoring, and charity fundraising
- value and respect people from all cultures and communities
- only use social media to be positive about the school

### **Treviglas Academy Standards**

And we expect all students to follow the Treviglas Academy Standards to make sure that everyone achieves their best. The standards are as follows:

1. Always listen to adults and reply politely
2. Wear correct uniform
3. Move on the bell
4. Don't swear
5. Walk calmly around the school
6. Stand behind chairs at the end of every lesson
7. Put litter in a bin or take it home in your bag
8. Keep mobile phones switched off and in your school bag
9. Don't wear headphones or earphones
10. Don't hang around in the toilets

**In addition, together, we commit ourselves to the following:**

**Treviglas Academy - We will:**

- care for your child's safety and well-being
- expect high standards, set clear rules, promote mutual respect and develop a sense of responsibility
- make every effort to ensure your child achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community
- provide a balanced curriculum to meet your child's individual needs
- keep you informed about your child's progress
- keep you informed about school matters, be welcoming to enquiries and responsive to concerns
- value and respect people from all cultures and communities
- educate about and promote positive use of social media platforms

**As a parent/carer – I/we will:**

- ensure all communications with the school and their staff will be polite and respectful
- make sure my/our child attends school in correct uniform, arrives on time and is properly equipped for school
- support the behaviour policy including the issuing of sanctions and be available at short notice to attend the school if my/our child is not meeting the required expectations for behaviour and/or uniform. Attend a parental meeting with either the Head of Year or a member of the Leadership Team if my child is returning to school following a Fixed Term Exclusion
- understand that an after school detention may mean that I have to arrange transport to collect my child. I understand this is my responsibility
- encourage my/our child to work hard and support them with their homework by regularly engaging with the relevant online resources/apps
- attend parents evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress
- make sure that time is not taken out of school unless it is urgent (including medical appointments)
- encourage my/our child to participate in the eXtra@ opportunities offered by the school
- contact the school if my/our child is unable to attend on the first day of absence and provide an explanation on my child's return
- provide all necessary contact details as requested and ensure someone is available to collect my/our child from school if needed
- value and respect people from all cultures and communities
- monitor my child's use of social media and encourage the positive use of it
- ensure that my child behaves responsibly and safely while travelling to and from school. I recognise that the use of the school bus may be removed if this is not the case
- Ensure, where applicable, that my child brings and shows their school bus pass every day. If it is misplaced I will order a replacement pass from the local authority
