Message from Mr Lewis

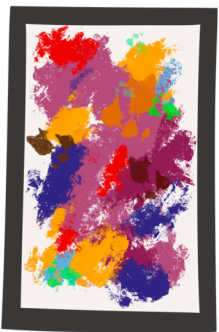

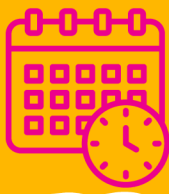
