

## KEY STAGE 4 RESULTS 2022

In 2022, students sat external examinations to gain their qualifications. This was the first year that students had been able to do this, since the pandemic. Despite the challenges faced by the pandemic, we have continued to build on improvement.

This year our Progress 8 score was 0.06.

This means that on average all of our students achieved higher grades across all their subjects, compared to similar students nationally.

66% of our students achieved the important benchmark of achieving a Grade 4+ in both English and Maths

41% of our students achieved the important benchmark of achieving a Grade 5+ in both English and Maths

16% of our students achieved a grade 7 and above in maths.

46% of our students achieved a grade 5 and above in maths.

70% of our students achieved a grade 4 and above in maths.

16% of our students achieved a grade 7 and above in English.

61% of our students achieved a grade 5 and above in English.

79% of our students achieved a grade 4 and above in English.

Art 83% achieved a grade 5 and above, 39% achieved a grade 7 and above

Biology 74% achieved a grade 5 and above, 40% achieved a grade 7 and above

Chemistry 82% achieved a grade 5 and above, 42% achieved a grade 7 and above

Music 79% achieved a grade 5 and above, 43% achieved a grade 7 and above

French 58% achieved a grade 5 and above, 21% achieved a grade 7 and above

Sport 91% achieved a Level 2 Pass or above

Travel and Tourism 100% achieved a Level 2 Pass or above

Engineering 72% achieved a Level 2 Pass or above

Health and Social Care 83% achieved a Level 2 Pass or above
