Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are writing to you with reference to the Activities Week planned for this academic year.

There are lots of exciting opportunities for our students this upcoming Activities Week, running from 13th – 17th July 2026.

This is an important opportunity for students to have fantastic learning opportunities outside the classroom. The activities selected will allow our students to build on their skills such as teamwork, communication and creativity/problem solving.

All of the activities have been selected with an emphasis on providing great opportunities with great value for money.

Some important points to note:

- We will review prices when we know the exact numbers per activity. However, we are confident that they should only change by a small amount (if at all)
- There are a variety of activities at a range of prices so both parents/guardians and students can choose the option that suits their budget and preference
- In terms of financial planning and support, we are allowing for payments to be spread over an allocated period of time
- An initial deposit will hold your child's place on these activities until full payment is received (even if you are choosing a free activity, places still need to be booked)
- Deadlines for full payment will be announced as soon as possible. The deadline for the deposits will be at the end of December
- As this year we are offering opportunities for the students to have residential trips, we are required to make payments in instalments to other companies at specific dates prior to travel
- Payments taken for students who have enrolled and later withdrawn can only be reimbursed if another student takes their place (this, of course, can never be guaranteed)
- If a trip is cancelled for reasons outside of our control, refunds will be issued in full but may be subject to delays due to national guidance, travel operator issues and/or insurance processes. Please be aware this process can and likely will take time, but the school will endeavour to reimburse as soon as we are able to
- By paying a deposit for any trip, you are confirming that you have read and understood the payment terms
- For residential trips all food is included, except for travelling time so additional money will be required to purchase food at these times and for general spending when away
- All students will be required to demonstrate excellent behaviour leading up to and during the activities. Any students who fail to meet these standards will remain in school or will be collected from the activity. There will be no refunds for missed activities due to poor/unsafe behaviour
- Based upon the feedback we received last year about children being in friendship groups, this year we will allow students to choose groupings prior to the activities, these will be on specific dates and so if the child misses these dates/times then groups will be allocated for them.
- You will be notified when the booking system will be opened
- Students will not be able to switch groups after the shared deadline as paperwork has to be completed and sent off to be approved well in advance of the events


Year 7 Rotating Activities Week.
